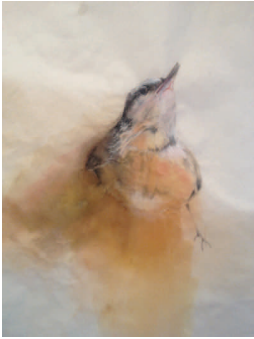
Six Senses: An All Juried Show

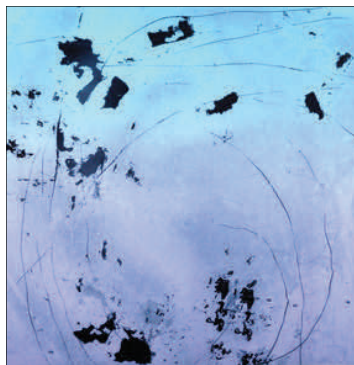

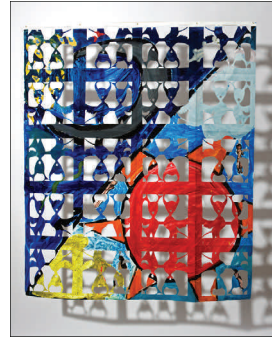

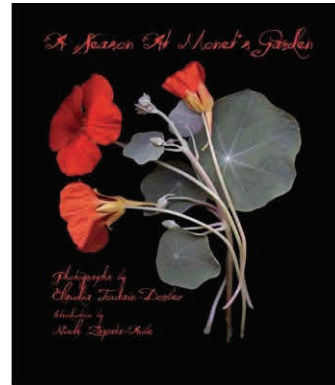
