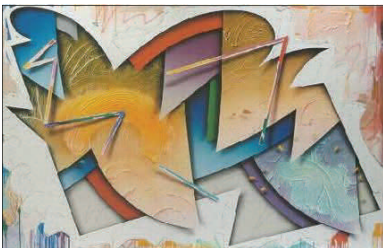

A Volunteer Opportunity That Feeds the Artist's Soul

The gallery provides an important venue for emerging and professional artists from the region. A non-profit organization, the gallery is run primarily by a volunteer staff from the Cannon Beach community.

Artists interested in volunteering their time have the added advantage of being able to show their original artwork on the gallery's Volunteer Wall, as well as participating in the annual Docents Show during the month of December. Students can receive work experience in the arts field while meeting artists and visitors to the area.

A minimal time commitment is all that is required. Docents are asked to fill in two three hour shifts twice a month. The shifts are broken up between 10-1 am and 1-4 pm Thursday - Mondays. Summer Art Camp

We had an incredible time during our 2008 Summer Art Camp. Our new location, at the Cannon Beach Elementary School, allowed us to play and make art outside in the summer sun. We had five classes: Encaustic Painting for 6-8th grades students taught by **Susan Simon**, Dance taught by **C.C. Sibony**, Bookmaking taught by **Barabra Temple-Ayres**, Trash Art taught by **Emily Thomas**, and Fabric painting taught by **Lark Miller**. Susan Simon's students worked with pigments and wax to create several encaustic paintings and a clever treasure box. C.C. Sibony's dance class had a small number of participants, but ended



up with a fabulous show at the end of the week, presenting hip hop dance and various acrobatic attempts. Bookmaking was our most popular class this summer, with Barbara Temple Ayres teaching printmaking and several ways to bind books. The Trash Art class students enjoyed sifting through trash to make costumes, including hat, shoes, shirts and other accessories



mostly out of recycled goods. It was a great way for children's imaginations to soar. Finally Fabric Painting, lead by Lark Miller, produced some incredible tie-dyes shirts, sun prints and block printed fabrics. The last day, over a hundred family members came to view the artwork and performances. It proved to be another successful summer camp.

Scholarship Program

The Cannon Beach Arts Association awarded \$2,500 in scholarships to graduating Seaside High School students. All of the students exhibited a strong interest in the arts; which included literary, performing, music and visual arts.

Brena Bruijn was awarded \$1,000 and is attending the Portland Art Institute. **Jennifer Bletscher** was awarded \$1,000 and is attending Seattle Pacific University. **Maya Dooley** was awarded \$500 and is attending the University of Oregon.

The scholarship program will continue in 2009. More information can be obtained from Seaside High School's scholarship department.
